

Management Committee News – April 2019

The newly formed HMCCQ Management Committee held its first meeting at the Alderley Arms Hotel, Brisbane on 29 April 2019. The meeting was attended by Ken Butler, Sherri Woods, Rob Mutimer, Paul Norrish, Dave Shipley, Steve Wright and Bill Stephens. Following is a summary of the main discussion and outcomes of the meeting.

The new Membership Secretary highlighted that three issues need to be addressed with regard to new membership applications – the requirement for a mover and seconder is often not adhered to, new members don't understand confidentiality ramifications, and incorrect pro-rata fees are being paid. The Club Membership Application Form has been updated, which will hopefully address some of these issues.

The Membership Secretary will be away from 22 May to 16 August. Judith Holzigal has agreed to relieve in the role for the period (thanks Judith).

The Regalia Officer has highlighted the need to consider regalia for the 50th anniversary next year, allowing time for design, discussion, ordering and supply.

The Webmaster has made a number of recommendations pertaining to the website and email communication. Further research is being undertaken and a proposal will be brought to the next meeting on how to progress with various improvements.

The President suggested that the Club should have an honour board. It was agreed that Secretary will research and update the required details and the honour board will be uploaded to the website when completed.

25 new SIVS application forms were completed during April.

As at 29 April the Club had 1,151 financial members, including 13 new members who were proposed and accepted into the Club.
